 - Associates Degree or higher from an accredited college or university. You may submit unofficial transcripts prior to the start of class to satisfy this requirement, provided that official transcripts are sent as proof within 30 days after the class start date.
 - At least 2 years of full-time study or equivalent from an accredited college or university with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher. You may submit unofficial transcripts prior to the start of class to satisfy this requirement, provided that official transcripts are sent as proof within 30 days after the class start date.
 - Previous completion of a state recognized EMT training course with a grade of "C" or higher within the past 5 years.
 - ASSET Score of 39 or higher or COMPASS Score of 82 or higher or ACCUPLACER Score of 70 or higher. To take the COMPASS exam, register by calling **(800) 728-0209** or go to www.arizonaemt.com for more information;
 - ASSET Score of less than 39, but higher than or equal to 36 or COMPASS Score of less than 82, but higher than or equal to 70 or ACCUPLACER score of less than 70, but higher than or equal to 53. To take the COMPASS exam, register by calling **(800) 728-0209** or go to www.arizonaemt.com for more information.

- The applicant must be eighteen years of age or older at the time he or she starts his or her program of study. Participants who are less than 18 years of age at the time of registration, must provide parental approval of all written and electronic forms.
- Accepted applicants are bound to the agreement contained on the registration form.
- Proficiency in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (Not Expiring within the next 6 months, taken with a LIVE instructor), demonstrated by one of the following:
 - EMS University CPR for the Healthcare Provider which you may schedule by calling **(800) 728-0209** or by going to www.phoenixcpr.org (in Phoenix) or www.tucsoncpr.com (in Tucson) or
 - AHA Healthcare Provider certification or
 - ASHI CPR Pro or
 - American Red Cross Professional Rescuer CPR certification.
- The applicant must demonstrate proficiency in reading at the 9th grade level. This will be verified through the presence of a High School Diploma, Home School Diploma or GED. Submit this documentation with your application packet.
- Negative Drug Screening Test - **not required prior to entry, but required prior to externship participation** - (must be 5 panel or greater and completed within 3 months prior to the program start). Students can arrange for a drug screening at www.resultstesting.com or by calling **(623) 266-7700**. You can also visit www.anylabtestnow.com or call **(602) 955-0240**.
- Negative TB Test - **not required prior to entry, but required prior to externship participation** - which may include either a PPD or chest X-ray with negative indication. Students can arrange for a TB Test at www.resultstesting.com or by calling **(623) 266-7700**. You can also visit www.anylabtestnow.com or call **(602) 955-0240**.
- MMR vaccination or immunity. - **not required prior to entry, but required prior to externship participation** - Students can arrange for an MMR vaccination at www.resultstesting.com or by calling **(623) 266-7700**. You can also visit www.anylabtestnow.com or call **(602) 955-0240**.
- Varicella vaccination or immunity. - **not required prior to entry, but required prior to externship participation** - Students can arrange for an Varicella vaccination at www.resultstesting.com or by calling **(623) 266-7700**. You can also visit www.anylabtestnow.com or call **(602) 955-0240**.



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- Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (TDAP) vaccination - **not required prior to entry, but required prior to externship participation** - within the last 10 years or immunity. Students can arrange for a TDAP vaccination at www.resultstesting.com or by calling **(623) 266-7700**. You can also visit www.anylabtestnow.com or call **(602) 955-0240**.
- Hepatitis B vaccination, immunity, or signed declination form which can be obtained at www.arizonaemt.com. - **not required prior to entry, but required prior to externship participation** - Students can arrange for an Hepatitis B vaccination at www.resultstesting.com or by calling **(623) 266-7700**. You can also visit www.anylabtestnow.com or call **(602) 955-0240**.
- Flu vaccination for the current season or waiver. Note, the waiver may not be available in all externship locations or may require the student to meet other restrictions/requirements, such as wearing a mask during time spend in the hospital, etc... - **not required prior to entry, but required prior to externship participation** - Students can arrange for a Flu vaccination at www.resultstesting.com or by calling **(623) 266-7700**. You can also visit www.anylabtestnow.com or call **(602) 955-0240**.
- DPS Fingerprint Clearance Card - - **not required prior to entry, but required prior to externship participation** - Obtaining a fingerprint clearance card takes 6+ weeks. Therefore, it is helpful to complete this step be prior to entry into the program. You can arrange for fingerprinting by going to www.resultstesting.com or by calling **(623) 266-7700**. The cost varies (between \$10-\$25) for the fingerprinting (payable on the day of service) and \$65 for the application to the Arizona Department of Public Safety.
