	Negative TB Test which may include either a PPD or chest X-ray with negative

	MMR vaccination or immunity. not required prior to entry, but required prior to externship participation. Students can arrange for an MMR vaccination at Any Lab Test Now or call (602) 955-0240.
	Varicella vaccination or immunity. not required prior to entry, but required prior to externship participation. Students can arrange for an Varicella vaccination at Any Lab Test Now or call (602) 955-0240.
	Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis vaccination within the last 10 years or
	immunity. not required prior to entry, but required prior to externship
	participation. Students can arrange for a TDAP vaccination at Any Lab Test Now or call (602) 955-0240.
	Hepatitis B vaccination, immunity, or signed Hepatitis B Declination Form. not required prior to entry, but required prior to externship participation. Students can arrange for a Hepatitis B vaccination at Any Lab Test Now or call (602) 955-0240.



	Flu vaccination for the current season or waiver. Note, the waiver may not be available in all externship locations or may require the student to meet other restrictions/requirements, such as wearing a mask during time spend in the hospital, etc not required prior to entry, but required prior to externship participation. Students can arrange for an Flu vaccination at Any Lab Test Now or call (602) 955-0240.
	DPS Fingerprint clearance Card - not required prior to entry, but required prior to externship participation. Fingerprinting services will be offered on the first day of the class at 5PM for \$12.50 per student. Obtaining a fingerprint clearance card takes 6+ weeks. Therefore, it is helpful to complete this step prior to entry into the program. The cost varies (between \$10-\$25) for the fingerprinting (payable on the day of service) and \$65 for the application to the Arizona Department of Public Safety.
